

Our Geography Learning Question:

Why do so many British tourists choose to visit the Spanish city, Barcelona?

During this learning enquiry, we will explore where Spain is in the world using key geographical features (equator, tropics, continents etc). We will develop skills in using maps and atlases and gaining key physical and human information from them including finding out about population and climate. Children will be involved in their own research, to gain knowledge about this Spanish city and will compare Barcelona to other Spanish cities and our local city, Exeter. Working independently will be a key focus for our learning and children will be given opportunities to lead on their own learning throughout this learning enquiry.

English

In our writing we will work towards producing a persuasive piece encouraging people to visit the city of Barcelona. We will do this by learning from the structure and language features of similar texts.

In reading We will use a range of texts to gain information about Barcelona. We will use these texts to help us structure our own writing and gather vocabulary.

We will continue to read 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' by Onjali Q Rauf as our class book study. During these lessons, we will focus on:

- Developing comprehension of the text
- Exploring the characters and how they change throughout the book
- We will look at interpreting the text so that we are able to understand subtle clues in the text

Other books that we will read for pleasure include; Ferdinand and Lola's Fandango

Mathematics

Throughout this learning experience, we will finish our learning on place value and use skills learnt to help us add and subtract 4-digit numbers using exchanges. We will:

- Round numbers to the nearest 10 and 100
- Find 1, 10, 100, 1000 less than a given number
- Compare and order numbers
- Count in 25's
- Understand and explore and order negative numbers
- Read and write Roman numerals to 100
- Add and subtract 4-digit
 numbers involving exchanges
- Solve problems and puzzles.



Foundation Subjects:

P.E – Mr Minns will be teaching Year 4 PE and outdoor learning on Friday afternoons. Our indoor PE session will be on a Tuesday afternoon. Children can come into school in their PE kits on these days.

Music – We will be learning how to play notes A, B and C on the recorder including reading these notes and exploring how notes look different depending on how long they need to be played for.

RE – We will continue to explore the question 'What is the 'Trinity' and why is it important for Christians?
