Our Art Learning Enquiry in Year 6:

'How can I create a maquette that accurately depicts a character from Macbeth?'

During our learning enquiry, we will research sculpting techniques, plan a sculpture through drawing and sketching and use clay with confidence, using our technical knowledge to make models. We will also be considering how we can identify and overcome barriers to our well-being?

English

We will be using a retelling of 'Macbeth' written by Andrew Manning and Tony Ross to investigate the story and characters in the original Shakespeare play. We will also be exploring extracts of the original script and using it to comprehend the Shakespearean language, using our inference skills.

In reading, we will studying each section of the story in detail, examining the nuances and descriptive techniques used to describe each character.

In writing, we will be using the Dickens' description of Fagin as an exemplar for our own detailed descriptions of our chosen character from Macbeth.



Mathematics

Over the next four weeks we will be focusing on developing our mathematical knowledge and skills by:

- Forming equations
- Solving 1 and 2 step equations
- Finding pairs of unknown values
- Understanding and using ratio
- Calculating ratio
- Using scale factor
- Solving ratio and proportion problems

We will also be focusing on learning our multiplication facts and related decimal knowledge.
